**Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare
to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs**

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare. The amount of extra help you get will determine your total monthly plan premium as a member of our Plan.

This table shows you what your monthly plan premium will be if you get extra help.

UPMC *for Life* premiums includes coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.

UPMC *for Life* has a contract with Medicare to provide HMO and PPO Plans. Enrollment in UPMC *for Life* depends on contract renewal.

You must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium.
